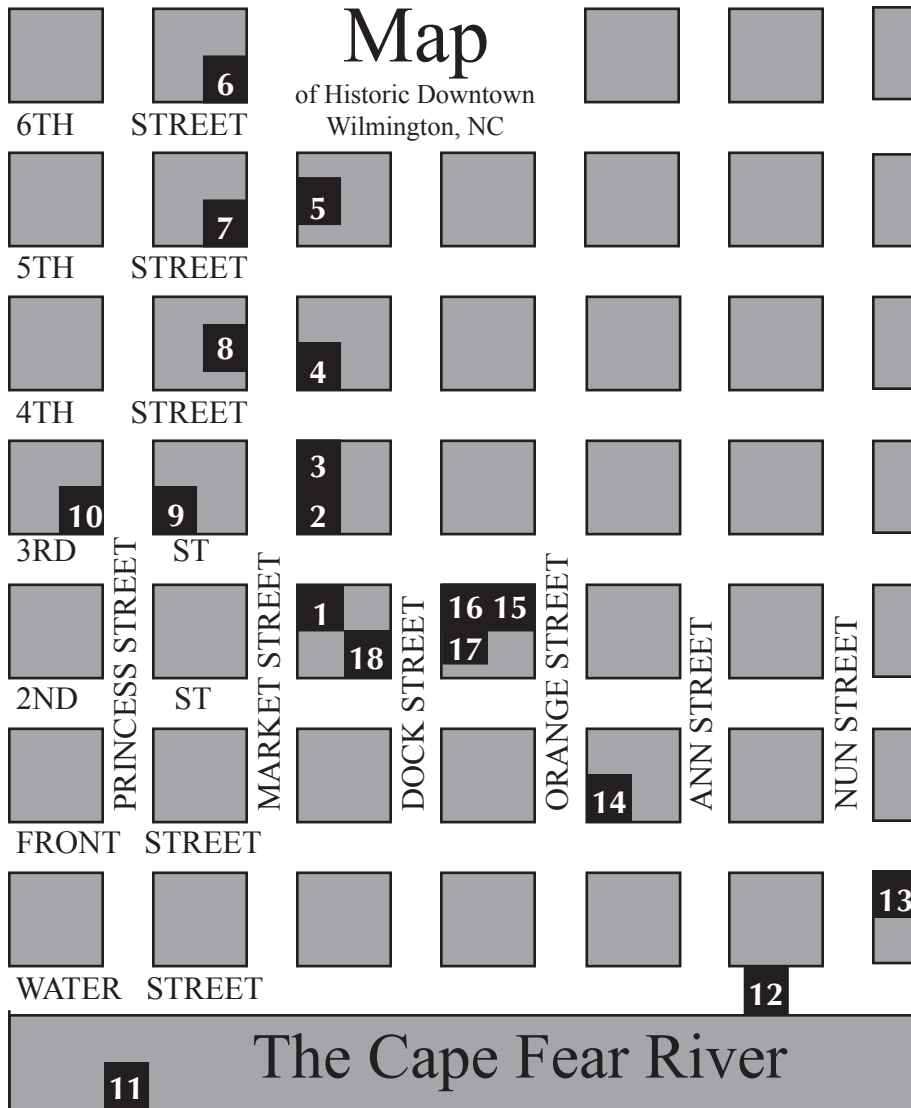
**14. Mitchell-Anderson House:** Front and Orange Streets
